
# ZERVAS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROJECT



New Utility work is ongoing, with the water and sewer lines installed. A couple of new utility structures and fire hydrants are installed as well. New 4,000 gal. grease trap has been installed. Temporary dewatering system has been installed and is operating. The emergency lane installation is currently ongoing with the installation of the fabric and stone. RAM Aggregate Piers has started and is also now completed. Excavation for concrete footings has commenced. Concrete contractor has mobilized and started to form and construct the rebar for the footings. First concrete pour for section of footings is scheduled for mid-April. Coordination of MEPs is currently taking place and ongoing with the underground mostly completed, ready for installation beginning of May.
