Waban Library, 1608 Beacon Street



- Roofing: 70% complete
- Framing: Area B exterior 75% complete 2nd/3rd floors, 1st floor to start 9/06
- Interior framing: Started on the 3rd floor
- Exterior sheathing: Started and is 30% complete
- Entire site is level and ready for the mason to start on 9/06
- Masonry: To start on 9/06 with stair wells, elevator and exterior wall veneer
- Light pole bases: At the north parking lot have been installed
- Spray foam insulation: Started and will continue to proceed following exterior sheathing
- MEP trades: Started and are well under way with rough ins (plumbing, Eelectrical and HVAC)
- Elevator is scheduled to be delivered on 12/05
- 1st floor slab is done all trades to mobilize to this floor and commence with work
- 90% of the gas main is installed onsite waiting on NGrid to complete the road work tie-in at the street
- All underground electrical & communications is done and waiting on transformer to be delivered from Eversource.
